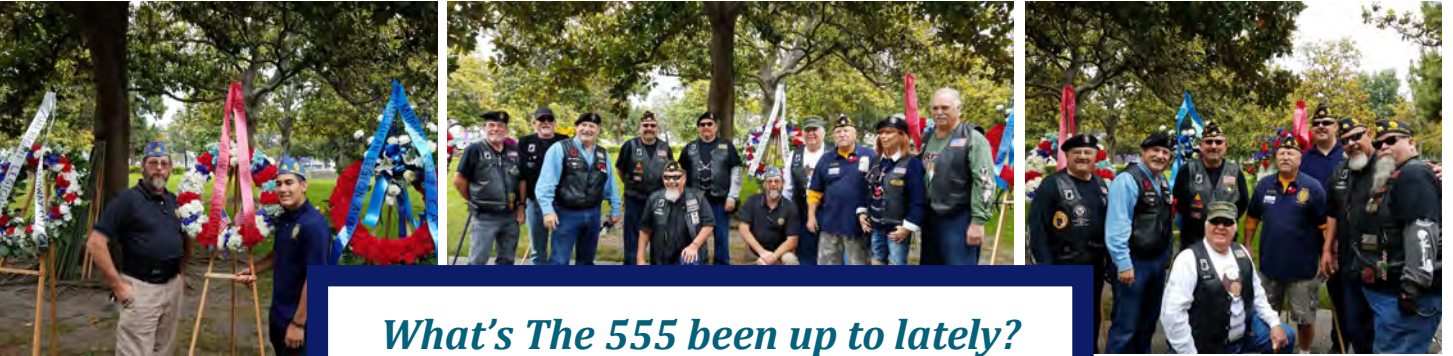

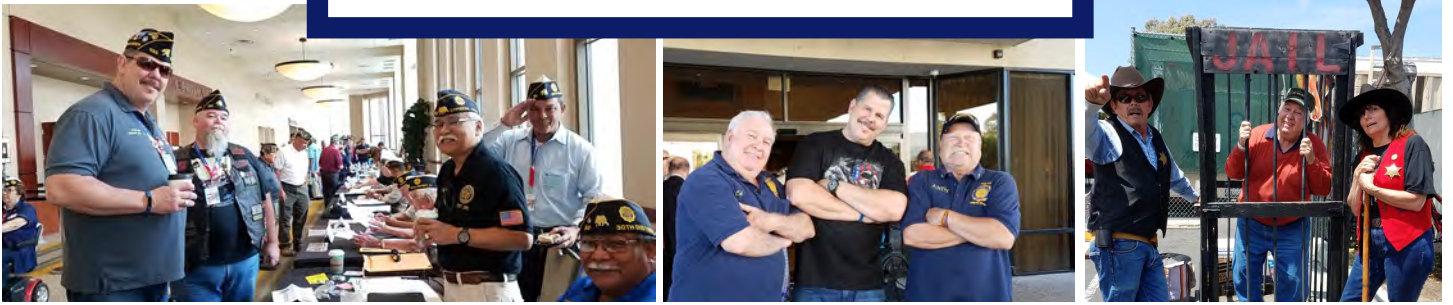

If you have a DD214, Do yourself a favor and take it to the VA and let them tell you what you qualify for. If you need hearing aids, you will be able to get them with just a copy.
