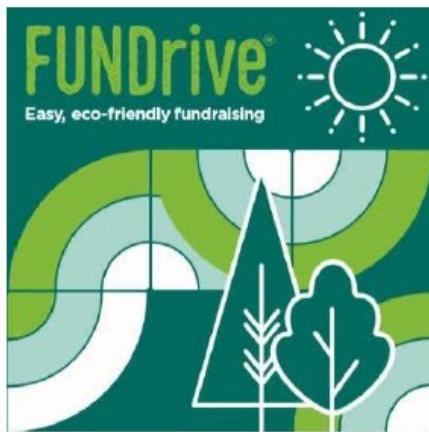
Greetings Fellow Legionnaires,
