Greetings Fellow Legionnaires,

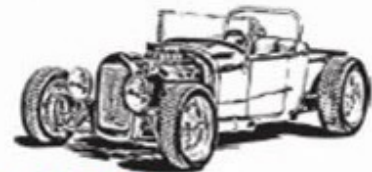
I'm at home recovering from hip surgery right now, but plan to be back in action in September.

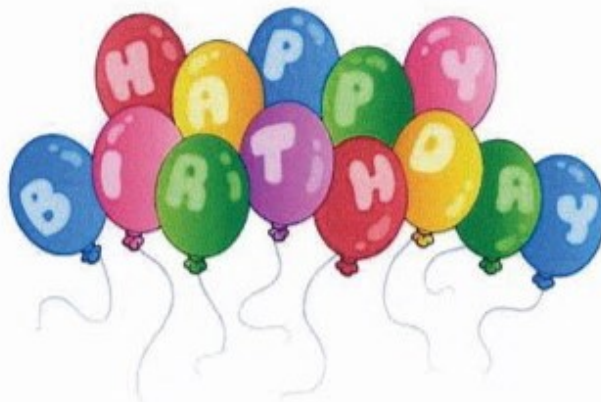
