It's time for me to ride!

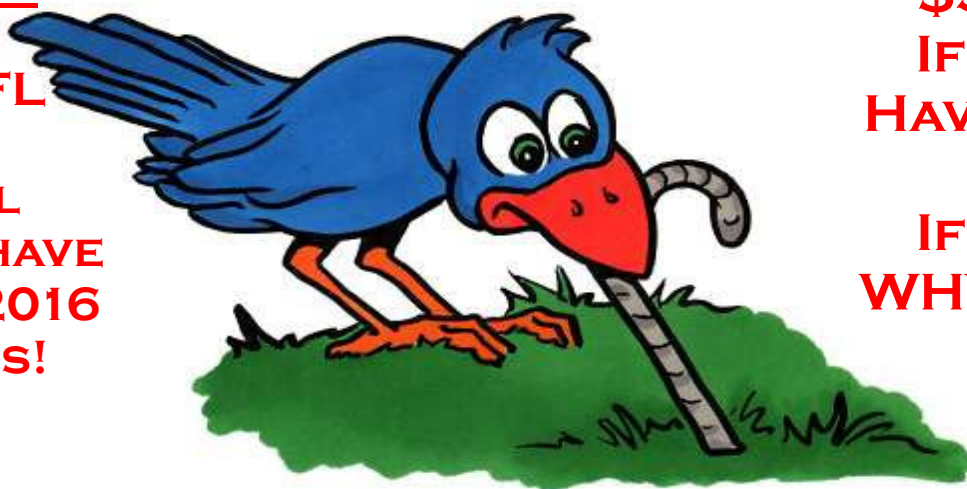

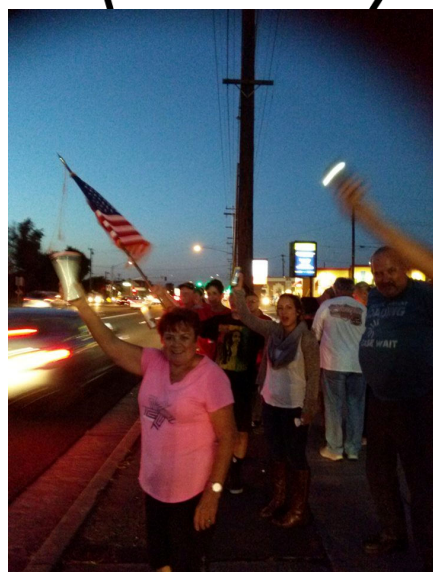

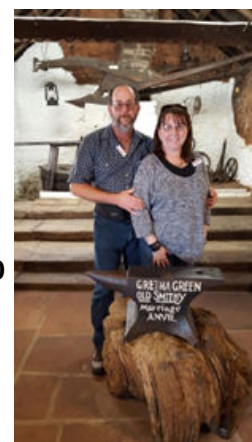
Our membership is climbing and if all goes well we will be at 62 members soon, thanks to all of you and George Willis for your hard work.

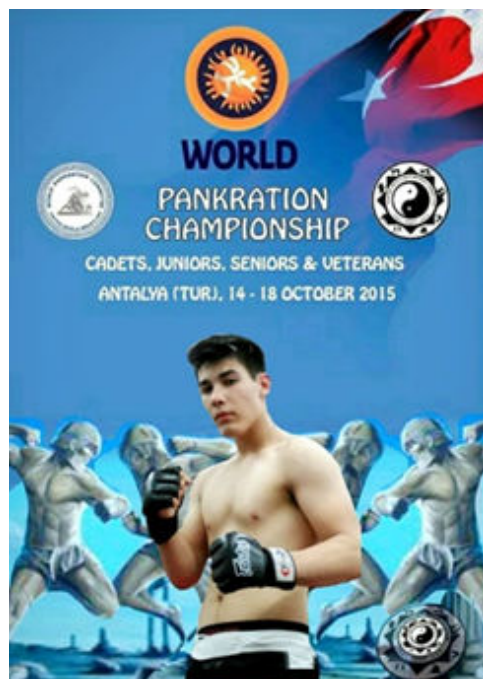

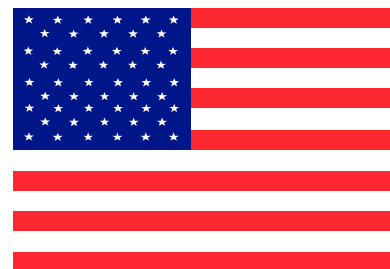
