

#### **LEGION FACTS: DID YOU KNOW?**

In 1919, the American Legion was chartered as a patriotic veterans organization devoted to mutual helpfulness. The American Legion was founded on four pillars of service and advocacy, each encompassing a variety of programs that benefit our nation's veterans, its service members, their families, the youth of America, and ordinary citizens.

The American Legion is the nation's largest wartime veteran service organization with more than 2.3 million members.

#### PILLAR I: VETERANS AFFAIRS & REHABILITATION (VA&R)

Since the Department of Veterans Affairs' establishment in 1930, the American Legion has maintained a key role in the VA health care system. The American Legion continues to advocate for veterans by lobbying for adequate funding, timely access to facilities, and claims assistance. In addition, the Legion supports veterans with special needs, such as those who have become homeless since discharge, veterans with TBI and other mental illness, those with multiple combat injuries, and those with battle related conditions such as Gulf War Syndrome, Agent Orange. Heroes to Hometowns is a VA&R program that enables severely injured service members successfully transition back into civilian life. Additionally, the American Legion also helps support veterans with education and career opportunities by participating in many outreach programs for veterans seeking employment and business opportunities. The Legion also works with the National Cemetery to ensure that all veterans receive a proper burial.

#### PILLAR II: NATIONAL SECURITY

The American Legion supports National Defense and the Department of Homeland Security. The legions holds positions on the many key aspects of National Security, including disaster preparedness, quality of life, and TRICARE transition to civilian life. The Legion's Foreign Relation Commission works with the Department of State to seek and maintain peaceful diplomatic relationships. The Legion supports full accounting and repatriation of POW/MIA military personnel. Operation Comfort Warriors is an American Legion program that provides comforting items to wounded service members in military hospitals around the world.

#### PILLAR III: AMERICANISM

The American Legion and patriotism are synonymous. The programs within the Americanism pillar include devotion to law and order, the raising of wholesome youth, respectful observance of patriotic holidays and remembrances, education, and law-abiding citizenship. Key programs include teaching the Pledge of Allegiance, educating the community of

patriotic holidays, flag rules, Voter Registration and participation. Other key programs also include support of the Boy Scouts of America, the establishment of the American Legion Legacy Scholarship Fund, participation in and support of Boys State, and American Legion Baseball.

#### PILLAR IV: CHILDREN & YOUTH

The American Legion's Children & Youth pillar is comprised of three primary objectives: to strengthen the family unit, to support quality organizations that provide services for children and youth, and to provide communities with wellrounded programs that meet the physical, educational, emotional and spiritual needs of young people. The Children & Youth Program supports many national organizations and programs including Children's Miracle Network, Ronald McDonald House, Special Olympics, and more. The Legion strongly supports traditional family values, assistance for atrisk children, and activities that promote their healthy and wholesome development. Listed on the pillar in the illustration above are the topics for which the Children & Youth Commission support.






